This exercise was practice with the RRI ICS213 form. This form is the updated ARRL RADIOGRAM form, first designed in 1945 and grew out of existing telegraph, military and commercial radio message handling. This is distinguished by being stripped of Excess characters and words.

Most telegrapher who could used a "mill" - a typewriter with only upper case characters. Uppercase is still preferred for message handling.

RRI numbered messages grew out of the ARRL numbered radiogram texts when the RRI came into prominence. They encode common messages into a single one to two digit number preceded by either RRI (general use) or ARL (ham use). When one is used, the group check is preceded by RRC or ARL.
